Vigil 1: North Side of the Church

Sitting roughly in the middle of the north church wall.

21:15 Steph feels a young girl around 6 or 7 walk up to her on her right side (from the direction of the back of the church). She had long straw blond hair with the front section tied up in a white ribbon. She was wearing a long pink strappy dress, which had a frill around the bottom. The girl is thin and comes across as being confident.

Richard has the impression of a young boy around 8 or 9 coming towards us from the same area.

Vigil 2: South Side of the Church

Sitting in front of the black gates.

Steph and Richard hear a noise like two coins being rubbed together or coins being dropped, towards the SE of the church.

Richard has the impression of a vicar standing in the area in front of the black gates welcoming people in to the church.

Steph gets a brief image of a man working patterns in to a long piece of stone with a hammer and chisel.

Vigil 3: Graveyard Opposite St Bartholomew's

Walking the length of the graveyard.

Steph and Richard both hear a sound like a low groan coming from the South West of the graveyard.

Vigil 4: West (front end) of the Church

Standing in front of the main door.

Steph and Richard heard a noise like the metal door cover bowing. Richard hears a 'click' noise coming from the direction of the North side of the church.

Repeated sounds heard like someone walking around in the dense tree/planted area to our right and also in front of us and to our left; a quick heavy trampling sound.

Steph has the feeling they are being watched and Richard describes the feeling as someone can see us but we can't see them.
