

# RESIDENTS ANALYSIS REPORT

One way of looking at the history of a site is through the people who lived there. This information can be gleaned from various sources including the National Census which was done every 10 years. Unfortunately the Census data is only released after 100 years (though the results of the demographic analysis are published shortly after a census is taken). This means that data is available from 1841 to 1901 in 10 year intervals. The census data is available to be purchased on CD but this would work out very expensive as prices are around £10 to £20 per county per census. Instead some data is available in main libraries or the county records offices (for Hertfordshire this is HALS, the Hertfordshire Archives and Local Studies, in Hertford). Data can also be obtained online but this usually means taking out a paid subscription.

The data for the analysis of the residents was obtained from HALS and ancestry.co.uk, and was analysed using software specially written by LPS. An analysis of the residents of a road can provide information about what was going on there, local employment and social conditions but the main thing is that it provides something very useful to LPS, the names. During an investigation LPS members, who have psychic abilities, will pick up on names which can then be compared with the records to see if the names were those of people who lived there. This analysis can be done before the investigation but no member of the team (apart from our researcher) sees the names so they are unaware of who lived there. An alternative approach is to look up the specific names in the data after the event.

Even though the census data goes back to 1841 a lot of it is of little value as it is not always possible to connect a name to an address. Analysis of names for the High Street revealed that the house numbers were only recorded from 1881 onwards. Prior to this each entry is only given a Schedule Number (a numeric reference to the data in the census). The schedule number is also given in the later censuses as well as the house number. Even without the house number it can still be possible to generally work out the residents in a road as the schedule numbers tend to be sequential. Two schedule numbers next to each other normally implies that the buildings were next to each other and using the sequence of resident's names over the years you can work out which building is which.

Better sources of information are the Registers of Electors which were produced annually but this data only includes those eligible to vote. As a result a lot of names will have been lost including children and lodgers etc. This situation gets worse with the pre-1900 registers as very few people were eligible to vote and eligibility was based on the value of the house, if it was less than £12 you couldn't vote.

In the analysis the full original data is given from the censuses, the rating analyses and the Hertfordshire guides. The latter were produced for a number of years from the early 1800s onwards and listed the trades-people and generally the business name (pubs are easy to find as the pub name is nearly always included). In 1910 every home in the High Street was evaluated for its rateable value, the data including the resident's name. This data is extremely useful as very detailed maps were produced showing every house and its number in the ratings lists. Within the lists themselves the house numbers were given thus allowing you to work out which houses were located where and whether there were areas out the back that were occupied. This was especially useful for the Rose and Crown as there was an extensive area out the back (the Rose and Crown Yard) that was used by numerous businesses over the years.

The image at the top of the next page shows the relevant section of the ratings map for the area of the High Street occupied by the Rose and Crown. This map has been highlighted in red to show the extent

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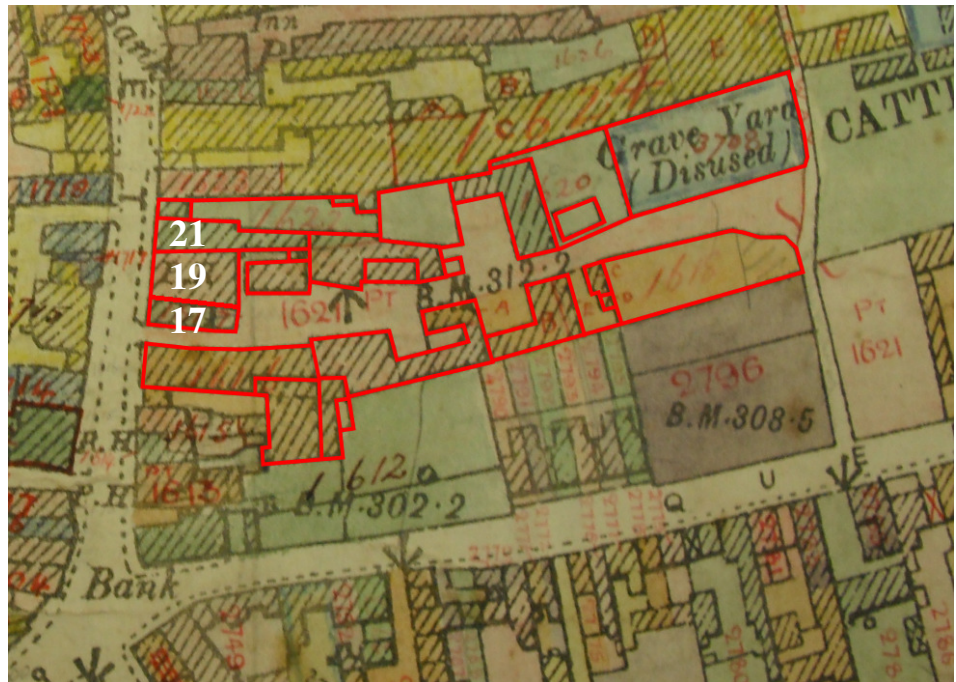
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of the buildings that were there at the time (the map used dated from 1897). As can be seen the buildings associated with numbers 17 to 21 and occupying an area known as the Rose and Crown Yard go back a long way from the pub. In a lot of the records just a business name was given for these buildings (e.g. Smith and Co.) and at present we are unsure as to whether or not the buildings were lived in or were just business premises. It is very likely that before 1900 these building were also residences especially as they were either stables (which would have had the stable lads living over them) or a blacksmiths.



It is surprising how extensive the Rose and Crown Yard was as a lot of it now lies under Figtree Hill, the road behind the pub. This can be seen on the image below which overlays the outlined 1910 buildings on a modern aerial view of the area (the vertical magenta line shows the modern extent of the pub grounds).

In the data which follows this summary the first sheet of the analysis ('Summary') shows the house numbers 17 to 21 and the people who lived there. This data is followed by alphabetical lists of the residents both by surname and first name ('Surnames' and 'First Names'). The next few sheets give the



1841 to 1901 census data. Normally the last sheet would be followed by the Register of Electors data but time has not permitted this analysis to be done (yet). The next sheet ('Guides') gives data obtained from various Hertfordshire guide books and directories. An example of an original census sheet is shown on the next page, this is a fairly easily read sheet, a lot of them are considerably worse.
