
Team 2 Report

Team 2: Stephanie, Marion, Daniel, Nicky, and Sharon


Location 1:

The temperature in this room remained a constant 9°C during the hour. At 11.50pm Stephanie and Sharon experienced small warm spots on the seating opposite the fireplace. The warm spots moved around a small area and were at knee height. This continued for about 5 to 7 minutes. Some team members felt uneasy at the rear of the men's kitchen near the ancient grave. Nicky and Sharon also reported intermittent cold sensations between the knee and ankle area.

Dowsing rods were used to try and communicate with any spirits but proved unsuccessful.




Location 2:



Team 2 observed Team 1 in the men's kitchen. Several light anomalies were seen but most were thought to have been dust from the seat underneath the camera although there was a few brighter orbs were seen that might need looking at more closely.


Location 3:

First temperature taken in this room was at 2.15am and registered 8°C. Team reported feeling colder at 2.30am. Temperature was taken and had actually risen to 12°C. At 2.45am Marion and Stephanie felt there was a presence in the room by Marion. Both felt that this wasn't threatening. During this time Stephanie witnessed small white lights between the end of the middle and far beds in the room. At 2.55am Daniel saw a small flash of light above the dressing table in the corner of the room.



Motion detectors were placed in front of the fireplace between Nicky and Marion. These were not set off. Trigger objects were placed on the fireplace and dressing table. These did not move.

Location 4:



Temperature on arrival in the barn was 9°C. At 3.35am Daniel related that he was feeling sick. Sharon observed that he was in fact swaying from side to side. He then decided to move away from the fireplace area. At 3.40am Stephanie heard a whistle/loud breath type noise behind her by the fireplace. These noises continued to be heard by team members in the middle of the room. The Dictaphone placed in the middle of the room caught one of these noises. Nicky also said she heard a small squeak like noise. This was also caught very faintly on Dictaphone. Shortly after these

occurrences, Marion drew a picture of a man (see below). She felt that this man was not evil but was not happy about us being in the barn. Temperature at 4am 10°C.




Orbs were caught on digital camera and a high EMF reading of 5 was recorded by the fireplace. Looking back at video footage, a small flash of light is caught on camera just after Daniel stated he is feeling unwell.

Location 5:

Temperature at 4.40am was 12°C. Pictures were taken and some orbs were caught. Sharon set up trigger objects in the small room on the windowsill and left her camera on lock off. Stephanie left her Dictaphone on the small dresser in the corner. 4.55am and Marion stated she is feeling queasy. Temperature recorded as 11°C. At 5.00am Sharon checked the trigger objects only to discover that they had in fact moved by quite a large margin.

The Attic






A quick check on the camcorder by Sharon could not identify any sudden movement of the objects. Temperature at 5.15am remained at 11°C.

Location 6:

Before this vigil started, trigger objects were placed and lock off cameras and Dictaphone were set up in the room. One lock off camera facing the haunted corner (where the Dictaphone was placed) caught a small flash of light.

Temperature at 5.35 was 13°C. Pictures taken with digital cameras were picking up orbs especially on the far side of the room by the bed and curtains. A Dictaphone was placed in the haunted corner of the bedroom and trigger objects were placed on the bed and one of the bedside cabinets. Temperature at 5.55am – 12°C. None of the team felt anything in the room. Stephanie's camcorder, which was placed on the table, captured a light anomaly moving in front of the bed.

EMF readings were taken during the night and nearly all places gave a very high reading. This was put down to the mass of electrical wiring throughout the building. Team 2 enjoyed the night and would take the opportunity to re-investigate the location at a later date.
