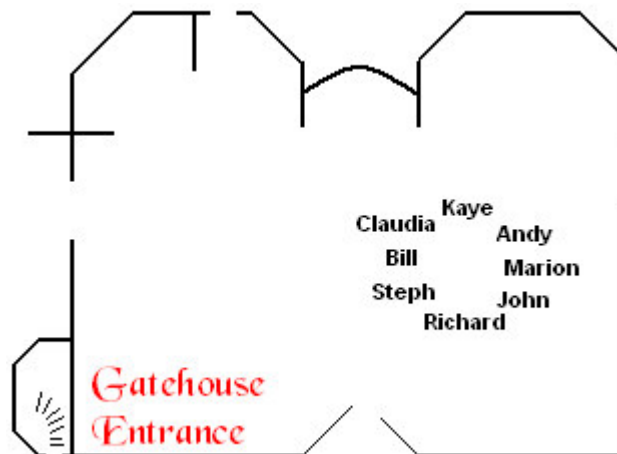
## Pre-Vigils

## Meditation: Gatehouse Entrance – 21:35 to 21:45

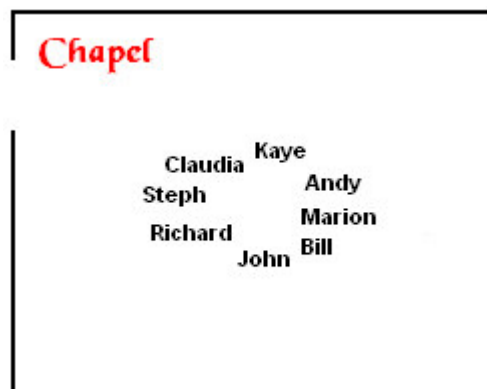

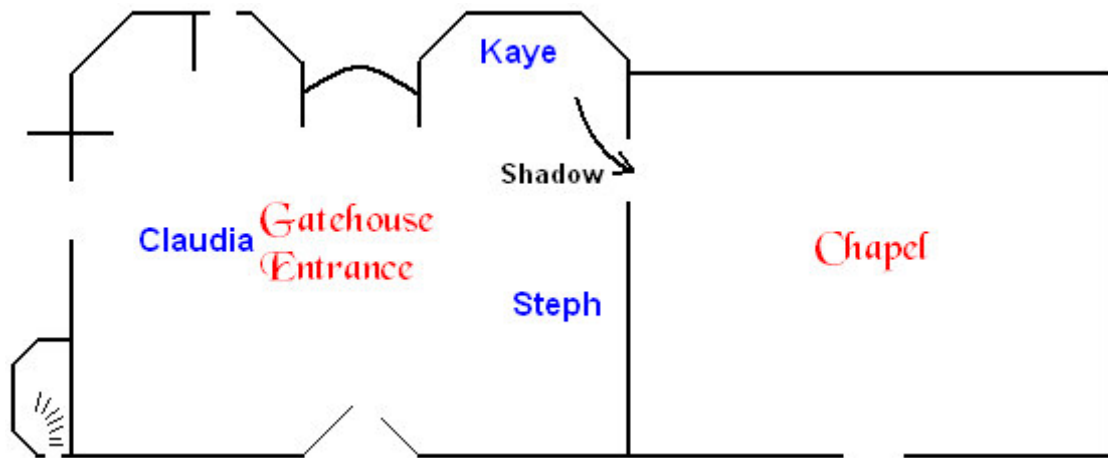

22:20 Steph hears what sounds like a woman humming a tune to her right.

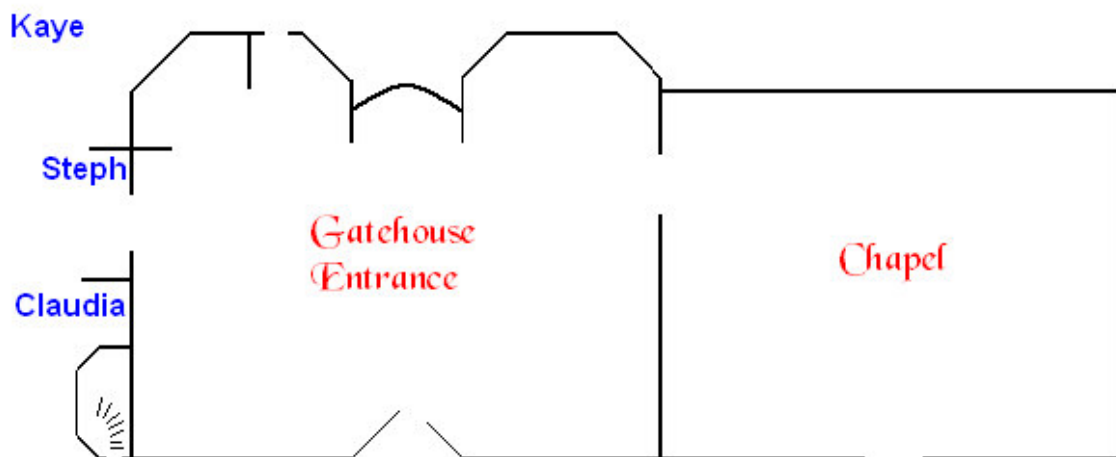
During the vigil, Kaye was standing in the octagonal turret next to the chapel. She picked up a woman and the name Maddie. She also picked up this young woman writing poetry.
