Pre-Investigation

20:05 While travelling to the investigation site on the A41 Elaine could smell TCP. Elaine asked Andy if he had used any which he replied ‘No’, this was strange as it only last a few seconds.

General

Vigil 1: Church Ruin – 21:50 to 22:30

21:52 Elaine and Sarah both saw a red light coming from the path area straight towards them. Then it veered off to its right, and disappeared. Bill was called over, and he had also seen this light. There was no noise. The light was too small to be a bicycle light; Bill investigated the path, and found nothing.

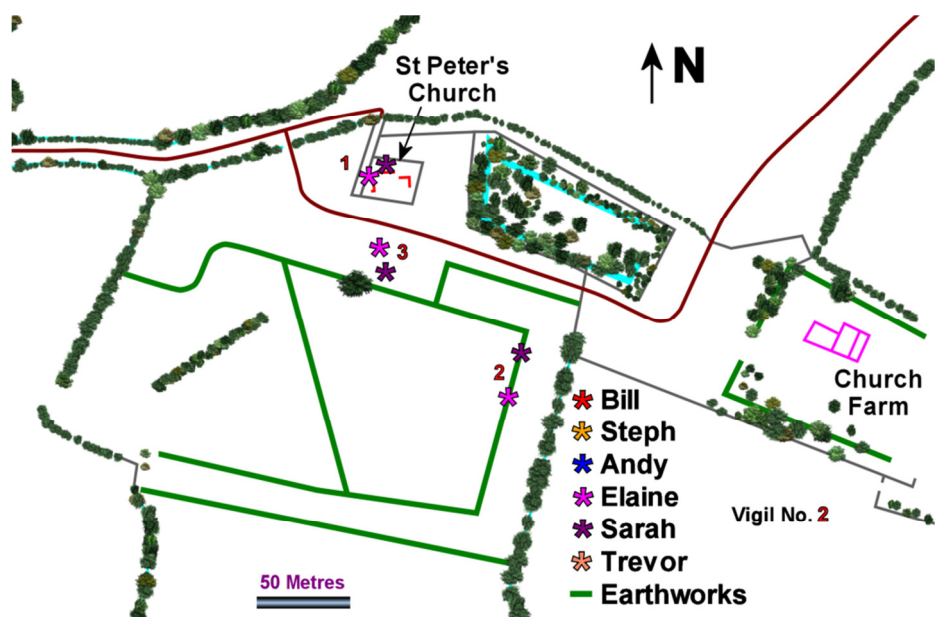
21:57 Bill goes down the path to investigate what the red light was.

22:13 Sarah saw a white flash from the same pathway, and then a knock (**Bill’s Note:** The white flash was likely to have been my torch, but the noise was not mine).

22:14 To Sarah’s left, as she was looking towards the pathway, Sarah saw a black figure movement in her peripheral vision.

22:15 Elaine gets the word *crystal*.

22:20 Elaine starts to meditate and sees people sitting on a dusty floor in a circle with a candle in the middle.

22:27 There had been a constant noise like wind in the trees leaves. Sarah saw the red light again coming toward them, but this time it went past them on the path, and it was some kind of electric tractor, which made hardly any noise! It shone the red beam into the field by the ruins, turned around and went back the way it came. Red light de-bunked!

22:28 While meditating Elaine sees a bright light, it was blue on the outside and white in the middle.

22:30 Sarah and Elaine both stand with their backs to the ruin so as not to be seen by the tractor.

Elaine felt peaceful in the ruins.

Vigil 2: Corner of Earthworks by Treeline – 22:45 to 23:15

For the positions of the team members see the plan on the preceding page.

22:45 Revelry from the nearby pub carried across the field.

22:52 Elaine hears ducks in the distance.

22:54 There was a lot of noise coming from undergrowth, Elaine felt uneasy and moves near Sarah.

22:57 Sarah felt warmer in this corner and calmer after the tractor incident.

23:12 Sarah was watching a plane disappear across the sky toward the A41, when a male voice near her right ear said “*Atheo Dei*”, or “*Attero Dei*” (see notes).

23:14 Elaine notices a lot of small flashes of lights and shadows moving around by Sarah.

Post-Vigil

23:16 While packing up to move to the next vigil Elaine hears the sound of a whip being cracked.

Vigil 3: By Fallen Tree – 23:25 to 00:00

For the positions of the team members see the plan on the preceding page.

23:25 The evening was getting much colder, and Sarah did not pick up on anything in this area.

23:38 As Elaine was looking towards Andy by the ruins, Elaine notices a dark figure standing to Andy’s left. At the end of the vigil Elaine asked Steph if she had moved to which Steph relied ‘No’.

23:46 As Elaine put her head up she noticed a fox standing a metre in front of her. Elaine tried to take the camera out of her pocket slowly; the fox looked and ran off in Steph and Andy’s direction.

Post-Investigation

Sarah researched the Latin phrase she heard:

AT HEO = (male singular) I see / am seeing / afterwards / from that place

DEI = Day

THEO = theologian

Or: ATTERO = weaken / ruin / erode / rub away

Which could literally translate as “I am seeing a theologian today” or “I am seeing ruins today”!!!

It could be interpreted in a few other ways.
