

After the first investigation at Blackgrove Wood on 12th June 2009, LPS returned on the 15th August 2009 as this is the date back in 1821 that the murdered body of the unknown woman was found.

With many haunted locations there is a specific date or time associated with a haunting or event that took place. This being an interest to many LPS members, it was decided to return to one particular recently investigated site.

A plethora of information was recorded by the members on the return investigation. Three vigils were conducted at Blackgrove Wood followed by a visit to the grave in All Saints Church.

Before the vigils started, a few members felt dizzy or light headed when walking through the wood and below are a summary of the experiences and information picked up and recorded during the vigils:

*Names/Words:* Kathleen, Irish, Smith/Blacksmith, Anne Brown, Jewishness, Green Diamond, Carter, Chase, Leather Hat, Stanley, Jane, Jack

*Audible:* Rustling of clothes, whispering, soft whistling (heard by two different members at different times), creaking of leather, walking on gravel when there is no gravel on site, footfalls and movement in the undergrowth

*Aromas:* Sweet tobacco

*Physical Sensations:* Pains in the right foot, pain in the jaw leading to the ear and a crushing sensation in the hands, stroke on the back of the hand.

*Visual:* Light anomalies including patches, flashes and streaks seen in white, blue and red, Shadows, Figures of men and a child, a dark haired woman.

*Coincidence or something else?*

There seemed to be an issue with neckwear at this site. One member lost their leather necklace on the previous investigation; another member removed their necklace with cross the day before the investigation and was nowhere to be found. Upon arrival, one member had their sunglasses on a chain around their neck and from arriving at the location to entering Blackgrove Wood it was discovered that the sunglasses had been broken. One of the arms was completely missing and removed from chain. At the end of the investigation yet another member discovered that their chain & cross had broken.

During one of the vigils in Blackgrove Wood, a member had the tune 'Men of Harlech' going through their mind. After the investigation this experience was mentioned during general conversation and it turned out that another two members were spending the last week of August in Harlech itself.
