Weather, moderate wind, very overcast with bright patches. Recent rain. Choir practise taking place in the church. Area generally quiet as the area has villages roads which are little used. A public house (The Bushel and Strike) stands to the west of the church and is generally quite noisy with the sound of laughter etc.

Vigil 1: North of Tower – 21:00 to 21:30


For this vigil we sat on the grass bank just to the east of the northwest entrance to the churchyard. For a plan of the site and the vigil locations see the plan below.

21:06 Stephanie was looking around the area; as she looks at the white house to her right she picks up the name 'Bernard'

21:08 Temperature +14°C.

21:09 Stephanie gets the impression of a woman with a flower wreath on her head dancing and spinning in front of her. She is happy and smiling and laughing. She has shoulder length light brown hair, which is very straight, and has a long light coloured dress on.

21:10 Stephanie can hear music playing as the woman is dancing. She can mainly hear drums but there are other instruments, which she cannot make out.



The woman seems to be focusing her attention on a particular person but Stephanie does not know whom. Stephanie feels as if she is standing in someone else's place as the woman keeps looking at her as she spins around but she feels it is not herself the woman is seeing.

21:15 Stephanie picks up the name 'Cauldwell' as she looks over at the local pub the Bushel and Strike

21:19 Bill hears a buzzing in his left ear but could not see a source. There were midges nearby but to his right and about 1.5 metres away.

21:24 Someone comes out of the north door of the church as the choir start to leave.

21:26 Bill gets a cold shiver down his back and across his shoulders. This was unlikely to have been due to what he had just been talking about as discussion immediately prior to the feeling had been about what looked like a crack in the tower and the way the power cables run up the outside.

Vigil 2: Southeast of the Church – 21:40 to 22:15

For this vigil we sat on a bench east-southeast of the south entrance, under a yew tree.

21:44 Stephanie picks up the name 'Meredith'.

21:46 Temperature +13.5°C.

21:47 Bill hears the sound of voices coming from the direction of the church to the north, at this time the church was thought to be empty.

21:50 Bill hears a click coming from the south in the tree.

21:53 Bill sees a large flash of light at the top of the tall tree to the south of the south entrance. This is unlikely to have been due to the other teams as the light was on the north side of the tree. This would mean that the light would have to have come from the team to the north of the tower but the tower stands between the team location and the tree.

21:56 Out of the corner of his eye Bill briefly sees a small black shape on the path 20 metres to the southeast of the south door.

22:05 Steph hears a 'crunch' coming from Bill's left (to the south) whilst he hears what sounds like 'hooo'.

22:07 Bill hears a click coming from the direction of Team 1 to the west.

Vigil 3: South of south door – 22:10 to 22:49

22:34 Stephanie is standing to the left of the bench (looking from the SW path). As she looks down the SW path she sees a whitish wispy vertical long thin shape move along the path a few feet in the direction of the church.

22:35 Dog and owner walk along southwest path and out along southeast path closing gate as they go.

22:38 Temperature +14°C.

Weston

Lannock Hill – 23:35 to 00:20

For this part of the investigation the whole team walked down Lannock Hill from a point 220 metres west of the entrance to Lannock Manor Farm to a point 75 metres from the B197.

23:47 Bill had just taken a picture at a point about 125 metres from the B197 and facing down the hill (towards the B197) and was looking at the result on his camera when something went past him
