On our first trip to Millbrook we turned it into a bit of a ghost tour visiting all of the haunted locations and places of paranormal interest in the village.

We parked near the local hostelry (The Chequers) and at 22:00 set out south along sandpit close until we reached the path up to the church opposite to the old rectory. The road along which we walked has the sounds of a ghostly horse as described in our website section on Sandhill Close and the rectory appears in the section on St Michael and All Angels and its own Rectory section. We walked up the

path from the road to the church then spent a little while walking around the church grounds. The night was dry but there had been rain earlier on so we were wary of taking pictures of moisture orbs and many photographs did show several of these. Nonetheless we did manage to take one interesting picture at the church which is shown in the image on the right. In this image a large orb appears over the heads of the LPS members but it



doesn't appear to be a moisture or dust orb. What is most unusual is the colour, a hint of yellow, which is unlike the artificially generated orbs we have photographed. These are usually blue/white, the colour of the flash on the camera, and a lot fainter. The colour could not have come from local lights as there aren't any and all torches were off at the time. Normal moisture orbs are shown in the image on the next page taken at the church ten minutes earlier.

After the church we followed the path towards the Woburn Road with the intention of reaching the point at grid reference TL019382 where several paranormal phenomena have occurred in the past (see our Woburn Road section). Unfortunately we found that the path no longer goes straight to the road but deviates through Ossory Farm which we chose not to enter so we returned along the path to the cross roads above Warren Farm and joined the Woburn Road by the farm itself. From here we walked west to the top of Sandhill Close where the old sandpit used to be (Galloping Dick's home) then down

Sandhill Close back to the cars. Walking along the close we took numerous photographs most of which showed only moisture orbs as the air was still quite misty.

On this visit we heard nothing and were plagued by moisture orbs on our images but one (in the middle of the last page) we cannot explain.
