

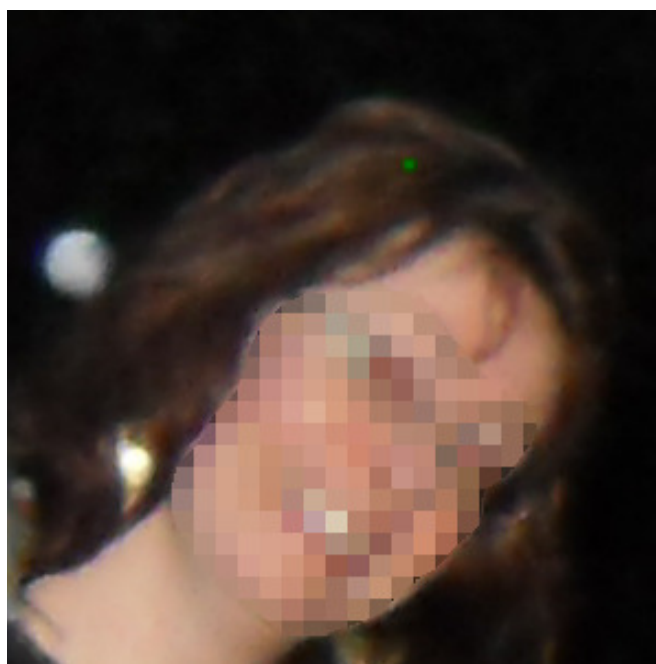

Pre-Investigation

Marion takes a photo of the group and there is a green light on Sarah's head as shown on the image on the right. She also has a couple of other photos with a green light on taken during the investigation. A close up of one of these is shown on the left. Analysis of the images reveals that the same green light occurs in the same place on each image so that it is camera related.



When we arrived at the wood it was just starting to rain lightly and Marion thought it would clear up as the weather forecast had predicted. WRONGIt tipped down all night .Most of the audio recording Marion took was of torrential rain and squelchy footsteps. The woods were pitch black and we kept bumping into each other in the dark. Marion thought the woods were lovely and would look great in daylight. They were quite quiet though, none of the usual animal and bird

Walk: The Outer Trail of Broxbourne Wood

20:41 Marion takes a photo of the start to a trail. As she takes the photo she sees two bright white lights through the camera lens.

Elaine could hear whistling.

Walk: The Sculpture Trail
