Houghton Conquest has two church locations. The first location I visited resembled what looked like an old Methodist church. A small area on the left side of the church does contain new graves but the church itself is derelict and locked up. According to locals it has not been used in a long time.

One interesting point about this location is that new houses have been built nearby. And one area of land next to the church clearly resembles an area where graves could be buried due to the uneven lay of the land. Also possible then that these new house have been built on top of the former cemetery.
