However, these can be explained as moths or other insects caught in the camera flash. I personally did not feel or pick anything up at this location and nothing except images of the group and some horses in a nearby field appear on film. John felt the team were drawn to one gate.

Cholesbury

Vigil 1: Embankment 21.50 to 22.30

John and myself took a location near to the wood entrance and near to the rear of the church building. During this vigil the sound of animals could be heard behind myself and John throughout most of the vigil and were probably in a nearby field. It was difficult to ascertain what type of animal was making the sounds.

22:15 John informs me that he can hear the sound of pigs behind him and was informed that there was no livestock in the area.

22:30 Vigil ends as Bill's team comes into view

Vigil 2: Ditch 22:44 to 23:10

John is sat near to an entrance and I have placed myself in the middle of the ditch. Unfortunately while setting up our equipment for this vigil a group of young people with torches began to make their way towards us. During the next half an hour, they kept disappearing and then re-appearing and trying to make contact in the dark. Therefore it made any attempt to investigate impractical at this location and as other teams were already in their vigils we decided to sit it out as best we could.

Vigil 3: Church Cemetery

Although we are joined by Steph's Team we are located in different areas of the churchyard. John is sat towards the rear of the building and I have sat myself near to where the majority of the graves are situated. During this vigil I take a number of photographs of a tree near to the gate because of a light

I looked behind me but no one looked as if they had done this and no one else mentioned it.
