### ***Pednor Bottom***

#### **General**

During the investigation the skies were fairly with plenty of sun and virtually no wind making for a very pleasant warm evening.

#### **Pre-Investigation**

I arrived on the site about an hour before the investigation was due to start so that I could do a video recording of part of the road. For the investigation we would be walking along the relevant section of the road which would make a fixed recording impossible as the camera could not be left unattended. I parked at the intended meeting place (the northern most point of the road where it turns a right angle) and set up the camera to record along the road, facing southeast, for just under one hour.

#### **Investigation: Pednor Bottom - 20:10 to 20:53**

For the investigation we walked as a group from the area where we had parked the cars (the northern most point of the road where it turns a right angle) to the junction with Westdean Lane to the west-southwest.

20:25 Temperature, approximately halfway down the road, +12°C. This was under the overhanging trees and was in an area which had not seen much sun.

20:52 Temperature, 20 metres from cars, +17.5°C. This area has low hedgerows and had been heated by the sun.

### ***Cholesbury***

#### **General**

During the investigation the skies were fairly clear with virtually no wind. Within the wooded areas there was a fair amount of mist especially high in the tree canopy and the ground vegetation was very damp mainly due to condensation.

#### **Pre-Investigation**

When we arrived on the site we discovered that a group of people were occupying the banks and ditch area to the north of the site. They remained there all the time we were on site and were making considerable noise. This did somewhat restrict the areas where we could hold vigils.

#### **Vigil 1: Ditch – 21:59 to 22:30**

For the positions of the team members during the vigils see the drawing at the end of the report.

For the first vigil we positioned ourselves at the bottom of the ditch about 40 metres from the point where the northern footpath crosses the banks and ditch. The area was relatively quiet with just a few

faint car and plane noises. There were also a lot of wildlife noises and intermittent loud sounds coming from the other group of people.

22:04 Temperature +11°C, the air smells very damp.

22:07 I notice several large flashes of light coming from the northwest and from up in the tree canopy. This is from the direction of the other people on the site but it did not appear to be torchlight. The flashes actually appeared to be flat shapes (no structure which you would have expected if the canopy was being lit up). One shape was a perfect triangle and appeared to be in the area where the path crosses the ring.

20:10 Marion picks up the name Magda (for a drawing of Magda see the end of this report).

The right side of her face + head feels numb and heavy. She feels like her head is covered by a hood or shawl. She sees an old woman walking past and old dwelling. She was poorly dressed in a long skirt and thought to have had a shawl and bonnet as Marion remembers seeing a white tied bow. The lady walked with a long stick that looked like it had been cut off a tree. Marion asks

*Q. 'Did you live here?'*

*A. 'Aye'*

*Q. 'What happened to your face?'*

*A. 'Twas born like it'*

22:13 I see a flash of light, measuring about 10cm by 2cm, in the region where Marion's face should have been (it was too dark to actually see her face).

22:25 Temperature +8.5°C.

22:26 Marion sees the lady again as a young girl. Marion tells her, despite her face she is beautiful. Marion then feels someone touch her on the right side of her head, which sent shivers through her.

22:28 Marion has her name called.

### **Vigil 2: Ditch – 22:43 to 23:15**

For this second vigil we decided to move further away from the noise coming from the other group of people on the site and positioned ourselves nearer to the church as shown on the diagram at the end of this report.

22:44 I develop a sudden, blinding, headache behind my right eye and the eye itself starts watering.

22:50 My emf meter beeps once. At the time it was not near any equipment like my camera and nothing was turned either off or on.

22:51 I am made acutely aware of the headache again which is still behind my right eye which continues to water.

22:53 I see a fast moving streak of pale light up in the trees to the north.

22:54 I hear a strange snorting sound coming from the north-northwest. This could have been from a horse (aerial photographs shown that in the past there were animals in the field, in the direction from which the sound came).

22:55 My head is now so bad it is painful to blink.

22:56 I see a flash of light above Marion.

22:59 I see a large triangle of light which seems to be placed between Marion and Andy S.

23:00 My headache persists.

23:01 Marion feels the back of her hair being stroked.

23:02 I see a ball of light falling slowly downwards and which appeared to be between 10 and 15 metres away.

23:05 Marion sees a white wispy shape pass her right side from front to back. Marion sees a small blue flash of light on the paper as she's writing her notes.

23:09 I notice a tiny flash of light behind Marion.

??:?? Marion sees the head of an ox. She also sees a tall thin man who looked like he was walking along the ditch. He had cropped dark hair and was carrying a metal half bowl with a high back that went to a point. Marion thinks this is an animal feeder that fixes to a wall or frame.

23:12 Temperature measured at +11.5°C.

23:14 Marion can hear people singing. She sees a gold bell hanging in an arch like you get over a church door when there is no bell tower.

The only thing Andy experienced was several very short wafts of Pig Manure. Andy asked Marion if she could smell anything and she said no.

Andy also took several pictures from this location which was almost totally covered over with trees and on one of the photos is what appears to be a clear full moon.

### **Vigil 3: Centre of Hill Fort – 23:26 to 00:00**

The first thing I notice at the start of this vigil is that my headache has gone.

23:32 Temperature measured at +10°C.

23:36 Marion senses someone in country camouflage looking through binoculars. She senses this twice.

23:38 Marion sees a dot of yellow light in front of her.

23:41 Marion picks up the words 'Disaster-dying-trust'.

23:49 Marion senses someone holding a soft leather shoe in their hands and can hear whispering.

23:52 Marion sees dark wood, which looked like oak. It was beautifully carved with circles, swirls and leaves.

23:55 I see a bright dot of light in the far left corner of the field (to the northwest) where the ring of trees meets the western hedgerow.

23:59 Temperature measured at +10°C.

Marions sees a chunky yellow 'W' with what looked like a leafy branch crossing it from bottom left to top right.

Marion's face is itching and she feels a presence to her left.
