General

Slightly cloudy, temperature approximately +20°C (±1°C). Moon phase 41% waxing.

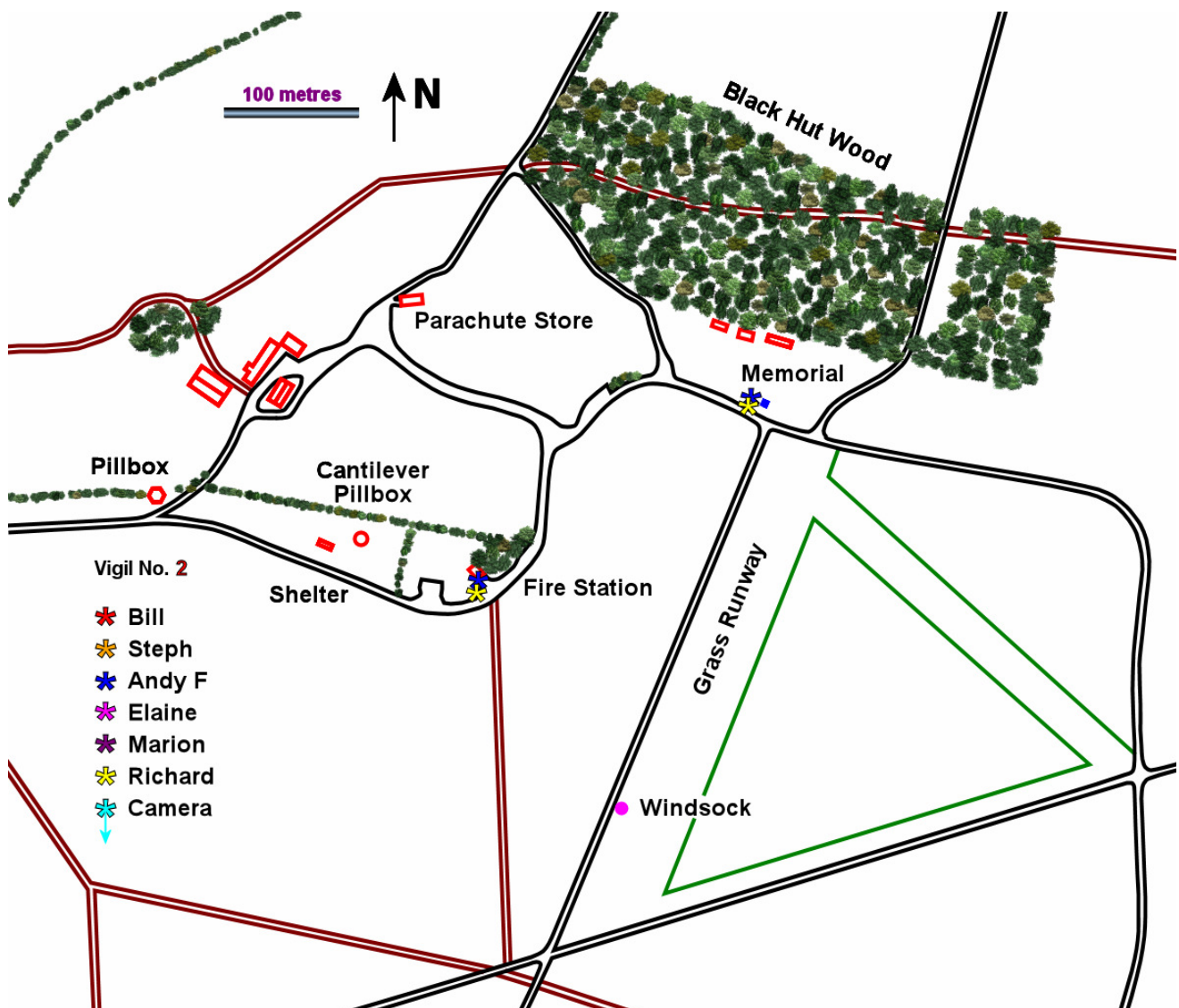
Ambient Sounds - Aircraft flying overhead.

Vigil 1: Airfield Memorial – 21:45 to 22:30

Andy and Richard have set up EMF recorders and sound recorders on the airfield memorial and Andy has set up his DVD camcorder on a tripod filming the meters for any sign of activity.

Andy and Richard are sat on a bench next to the airfield memorial. For the positions of the team members see the plan below.

21:47 Andy takes a temperature reading of +20°C.

- 21:48 EVP session starts.
- 21:52 Richard moves his sound recorder to the same side of the airfield memorial as Andy's and set up was complete.
- 21:53 Andy and Richard agree to do this part of the vigil as a silent vigil to be followed by an EVP experiment.
- 22:03 Richard heard a faint screeching sound in the distance.
- 22:09 Richard heard the sound of a train in Harlow, heard twice.
- 22:15 Andy and Richard are now standing next to the airfield memorial and the EVP experiment begins
- 22:18 Richard heard a faint whisper in his left ear from over his shoulder and sensed a man in the distance.
- 22:19 Richard observes the EMF meter goes 'crazy' four lights were seen 'flickering'.
Andy and Richard then observe another two lights flicker on the EMF meter.
Andy informs Richard that he feels the area behind him has gone really cold. Andy takes a temperature reading in front of him and this reads as +20°C. Andy takes a temperature reading behind him and this reads as +17°C.
Richard informs Andy that his right arm is going cold. Andy measures Richards's right arm at 17°C and the other arm at 21°C.
- 22:21 Andy takes another temperature reading is measured as +17°C behind the fixed camera and 21°C in front of it around/on the airfield memorial.
- 22:30 As Bill calls over the radio for the end of the first vigil, both Andy and Richard observe a dramatic increase in EMF activity with pulse flash lasting approximately 2 to 3 seconds. This EMF activity is caught on the camcorder. Andy informs Bill that the team should stay put and this is agreed.

Vigil 2: Airfield Memorial – 22:30 to 23:15

Andy and Richard are sat on a bench next to the airfield memorial. For the positions of the team members see the plan on the previous page.

- 22:33 It seems to Richard at this time he always feels colder on his right hand side, no temperature measurement was taken however.
- 22:33 Andy takes a temperature reading for where he is standing and the reading goes down from 18°C to 15°C.
- 22:36 Richard feels a warm 'channel' of air is felt in a straight line from the memorial towards the glider.
- 22:36 Andy takes a temperature reading of 19°C.
- 22:44 Andy conducts a disc change on his camcorder. As EMF activity has ceased Andy and Richard return to sit on the bench to conduct silent vigils.
- 22:46 Richard feels a shiver on his right shoulder.

- 22:51 Andy and Richard hear voices in the distance that are probably from the town and/or the village. Andy hears the voice of a man.
- 22:53 Richard senses three white/off-greyish figures not far in front of him in a line, approximately 30 metres away, walking away at the edge of the gliding club.
- 22:54 Richard feels another cold shiver on his right shoulder.
- 22:55 Richard hears a distinct metallic sound, like keys jangling when somebody is walking, to the right of the bench, on the path directly away from the airfield memorial.
- 23:00 Andy and Richard end the silent vigil to undertake a second EVP session by the airfield memorial.
- 23:05 Richard sees a little red dot on the face of the airfield memorial, then all five lights on EMF meter flicker on, for approximately 3 to 4 seconds.
- 23:05 Andy hears someone sigh near him, but it is not Richard.
- 23:09 Richard felt a pain down his backside all the way down to his left foot and Andy states he is feeling cold again. Andy and Richard again observed the lights on the EMF meter stay on again, ranging from 1 and up to 5 lights numerous times before all going dead.
- 23:11 Andy observes the EMF meter spiking continuously for a few seconds.
- 23:13 Richard chants 'Stay on' at the EMF meter and it pulses and holds to 3 lights for approximately 8 seconds or so.
- 23:15 Andy and Richard observe three lights light up on the EMF meter again but put this down to the radio going off as Bill calls an end to this vigil.

Vigil 3: Fire Station – 23:30 to 00:03

Andy is standing near the pathway to the station and Richard is standing nearby. For the positions of the team members see the plan on page 1.

Temperature +19°C.

- 23:31 Richard picks up a mint like smell near the building.
- 23:32 Andy knocks his tripod over and breaks his camcorder. This completely interrupts this vigil as Andy and Richard spend time trying to fix the camera which is badly damaged and will not focus
- 23:48 Up until now the time has been spent by Richard and Andy looking at the damage to Andy's camera equipment and doing EVP recordings.
- 23:50 EVP session begins as the camera cannot be fixed at the location.
- 23:52 Richard's legs begin to feel suddenly heavy, this feeling lasts for a couple of minutes before subsiding.
- 23:53 Andy and Richard observe the light from some sort of machine inside the building that is flickering on and off repeatedly.
